This book is a compilation of references related to military services during wartime primarily for junior level officers. Rikichi Andō, the head of the Inspectorate-General of Military Training wrote the prologue.

Clause (2) "Removal of epidemics and stopping of contagion" in Section 4. "Prevention of epidemics" of Chapter 8 "Hygiene for men and horses" is worth noting. The clause states that "As far as venereal diseases are concerned, not only aggressive preventive measures should be considered but also sanitary facilities in the "comfort stations" should be fully prepared; further, contacts with prostitutes or locals should be strictly forbidden, except with those designated by the military."
