Annotation:

This document contains regulations on a range of logistics activities including rules on “comfort” facilities. The pertinent rules are as follows: Unit commanders in charge of logistics has the authority to designate or remove the designation of restaurants and “comfort stations” with the military’s approval. Necessary regulations shall be prescribed and enforced on the “comfort stations.” To ensure that the “comfort stations” charge a fair fee, the fees are subject to the military’s approval.
