Annotation:

This document presents general regulations regarding the use of “comfort stations.” The regulations are as follows: The service hours assigned to noncommissioned officers on their off days shall begin after 4pm; Military lodging and “comfort stations” are open every day between 9:30am and 6pm, except Fridays; the use of “comfort stations” in the morning is restricted to those who will be on duty in the afternoon on their unit’s assigned day off; noncommissioned officers or the lower ranks may use the “comfort stations” on their assigned off days, and they are strictly prohibited from travelling outside their bases or using “comfort stations” during workdays; warrant officers or the higher ranks may use “comfort stations” after the evening roll calls.
