Annotation:

This document describes matters to be attended to with respect to the installation of a “comfort station.” It states that that its location is in the east of the 47th infantry regiment, and the hourly rates shall be 2 yen for commissioned officers, 1.5 yen for noncommissioned officers, and 1 yen for soldiers, and the rates should be strictly observed. The document also adds that there are forty “comfort women” who shall be classified by the level of personal hygiene. Information on service hours, and suggestions and precautions about the use of “comfort stations” are included as well.
