Annotation:

This document is a report of the situation submitted by the 2nd Battalion of the Independent Siege Heavy Artillery. The report states that there are two types of “comfort” facilities – the one operated by the logistics unit and the other operated by the unit under the direct control of the Army. According to the report, approximately an hour is assigned to each unit on pre-determined date and hygiene examinations are performed in advance in the presence of a medical officer.
