Annotation:

This document reports that a Japanese soldier raped a 9-year-old girl who turned out to contract a venereal disease, hence urges Japanese soldiers to be cautious when using “comfort stations.” The document adds that the prostitutes serving as “comfort women” are required to carry a certificate if they pass a VD test, to which the soldiers should pay close attention.
